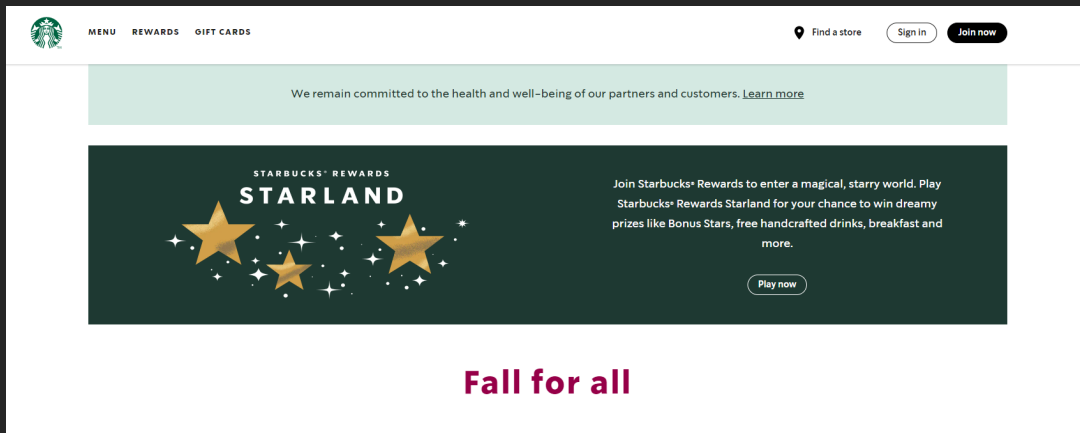

 - Click ... in top right of the post and select pin to top of page
- Update business hours
 - Update in page info on your page profile
- Set up instant reply messages on messenger for FAQ's
- Use messenger/DM with real time messaging
- Go live on Facebook or Instagram
 - Make in person events virtual

- Update hours
- Add attributes (new Covid Feature)
 - Dine in, take out, delivery
 - Online appointments (allows for a link)
 - Masks required, temp check, appointments/reservations required
- Add updates to a post
- Turn on messaging as a way for customers to reach you
- Update business description

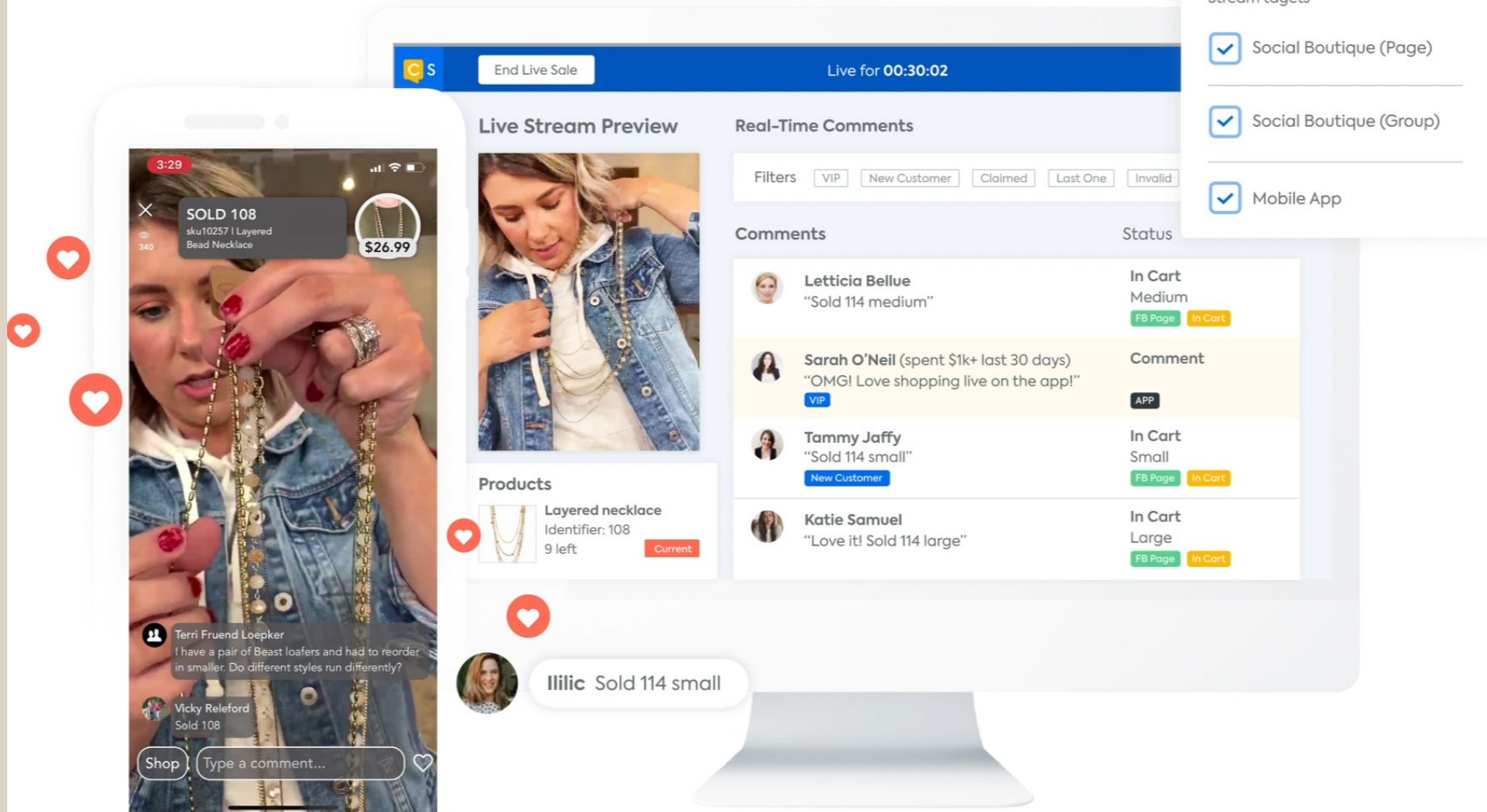
